I've lived in this neighbourhood for over 15 years now and just wanted to send my friends and neighbours a note encouraging them to get out and vote this Thursday June 12th.


I was raised in a family that stressed the importance of voting. To my parents it wasn't good enough just to care about your community, you had to get out there on Election Day and exercise your right to vote.
